



# Freeze \*R Burn



Endurance Ride 25/50/75

Endurance riding is a timed athletic event for both the horse and rider. The event is open to all breeds of equine (horses, mules and ponies). The goal is to follow a marked trail in the proper direction as described by ride management. The second goal is to ride the marked trail as quickly as the condition of the horse allows, successfully passing all vet checks and finishing with a sound horse. **“To Finish is to Win”**

Camping at TADRA Point is primitive. No human water is available; water for horses is a pond. No electricity is available. Plenty of parking for all size rigs. Campfires are allowed unless under drought conditions. All dogs **must** be on leash. Stores and motels are in Decatur, about 10 miles from campsite.

Trails. All trails are permanently marked. The trail varies from flat open areas to heavy woods, and is a scenic trail with deer, turkey and quail to keep a look out for. The trails are mostly sandy but there are some rocks from trail erosion. There is normally plenty of water on trail.

Riders are reminded if are you riding horses that might kick please tie red ribbon in tail. Yellow ribbons in tails are for stallions and green ribbons are for novice horses. All juniors must wear helmets. All juniors must ride with an adult who is entered in the same distance unless junior qualified to ride alone (14 yrs or older & 500 miles) they must show appropriate paperwork from AERC.

Horses entered in the 25 mile must be at least 48 months old. For the 25-mile ride you have 6 hours to complete, including vet hold. Horses entered in the 50/75 mile must be at least 60 months old. The 50 milers have 12 hrs to complete including vet holds. 75 milers have 18 hrs to complete. All horses must meet pulse criteria within 30 minutes in all vets hold or will be disqualified. If a rider pulls their horse from the ride they still have to present their horse before a vet.

Texas Animal Health Commission regulations require all horses must show proof of a negative EIA (Coggins) test within the previous 12 months. Please plan ahead, no exceptions will be made.

If you plan on attending, **please help ride management by pre-entering.** Postmark will be your entry date. Please mail by February 2nd!

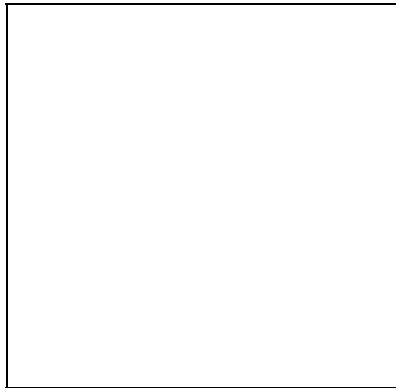

# Directions to Freeze 'R Burn Endurance Ride LBJ Grasslands, Decatur, TX

**Directions from Dallas:** I-35E north to I-35 in Denton continue north exit Highway 380W to Decatur, you will go west 24 miles to FM 730 (signs also say Airport) then go north 9.5 mile to CR 2461 (sign will also say Cemetery), 100 yards turn right on CR 2560 follow CR 2560 2.3 mile to road 900 (sign will say Cottonwood Lake) turn left it is then 1.8 miles to camp at TADRA Point.

**Directions from Fort Worth:** I-35W north to US-81, go northwest to US-287 then northwest US- 380 head east less than a mile to FM 730 (signs also say Airport) then go north 9.5 mile to CR 2461 (sign will also say Cemetery), 100 yards turn right on CR 2560 follow CR 2560 2.3 mile to road 900 (sign will say Cottonwood Lake) turn left it is then 1.8 miles to camp at TADRA Point.

**Direction from Oklahoma:** I-35 south to Highway 380 West [just north of Denton] to Decatur, you will go west 24 miles to FM 730 (signs also say Airport) then go north 9.5 mile to CR 2461 (sign will also say Cemetery), 100 yards turn right on CR 2560 follow CR 2560 2.3 mile to Road 900 (sign will say Cottonwood Lake) turn left it is then 1.8 miles to camp at TADRA Point .
